
ABOUT THE NATIONAL SEMINAR ON TEACHER EDUCATION (CONCERNS, CHALLENGES & INNOVATION)

GUIDELINES FOR PAPER SUBMISSION

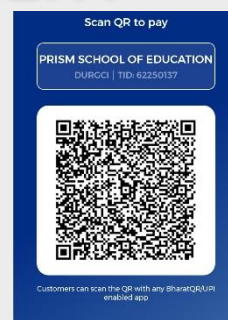
- Abstract - within 300 words
